IN HIS VERY OWN HOUSING DEVELOPMENT

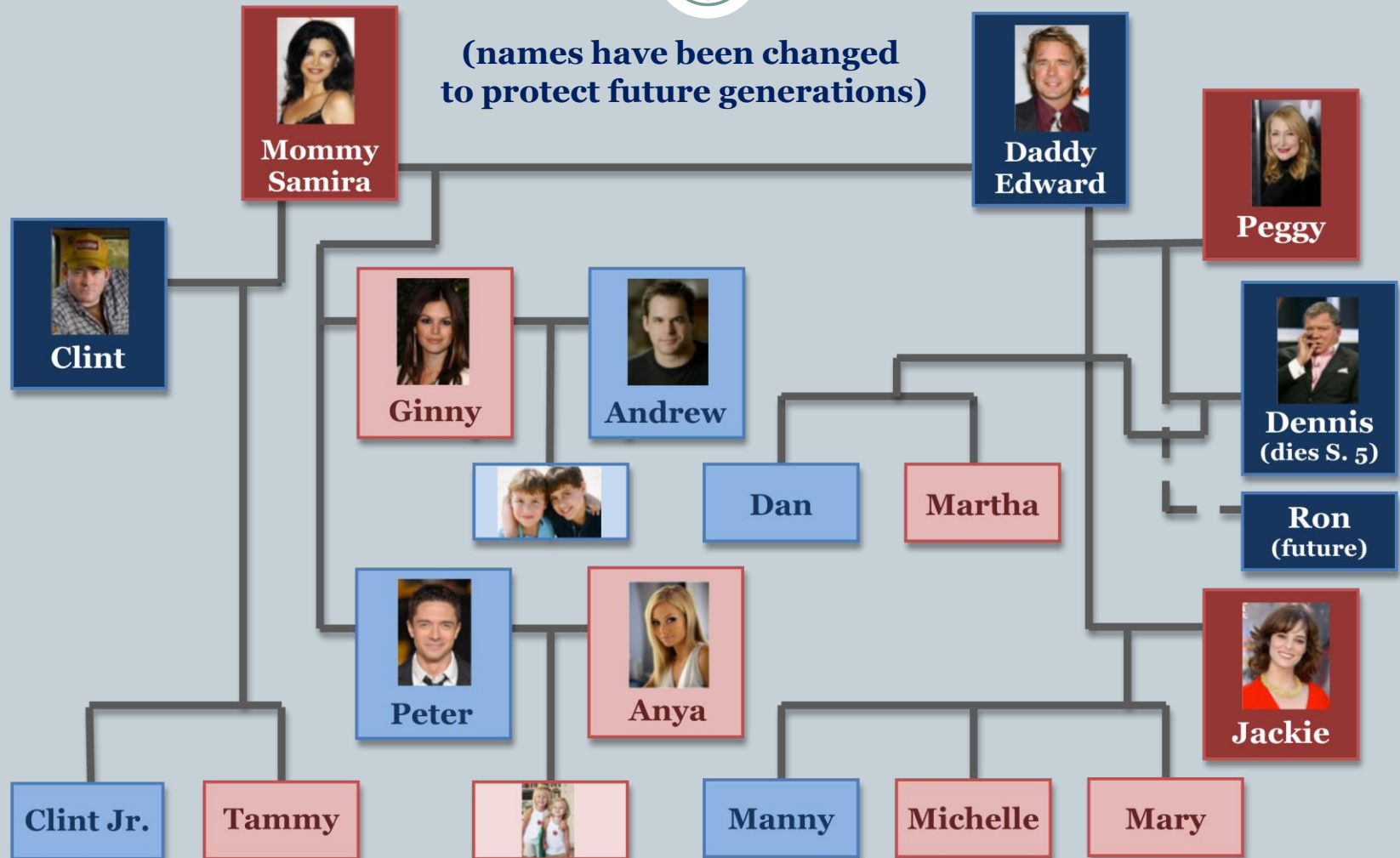


And they all lived happily ever after

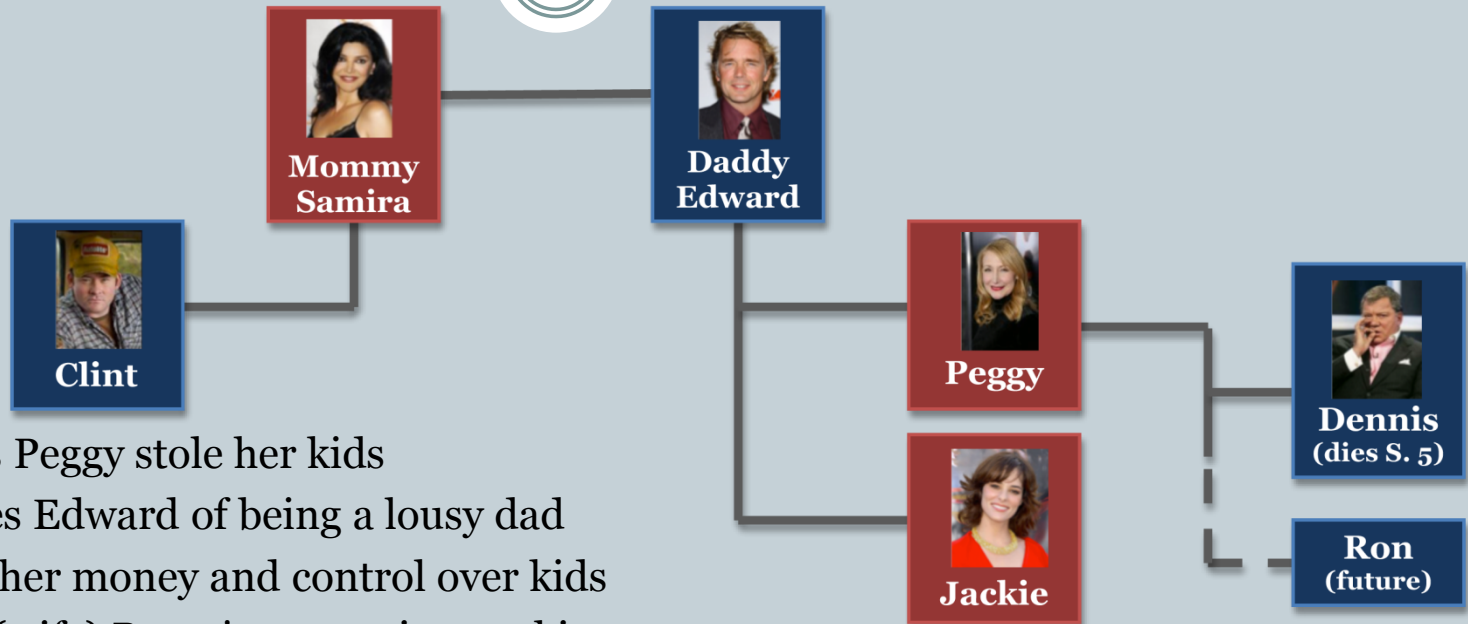
At least, that's what they'd like you to think

Minus 1 mom and 2 dads, if you can believe *that*



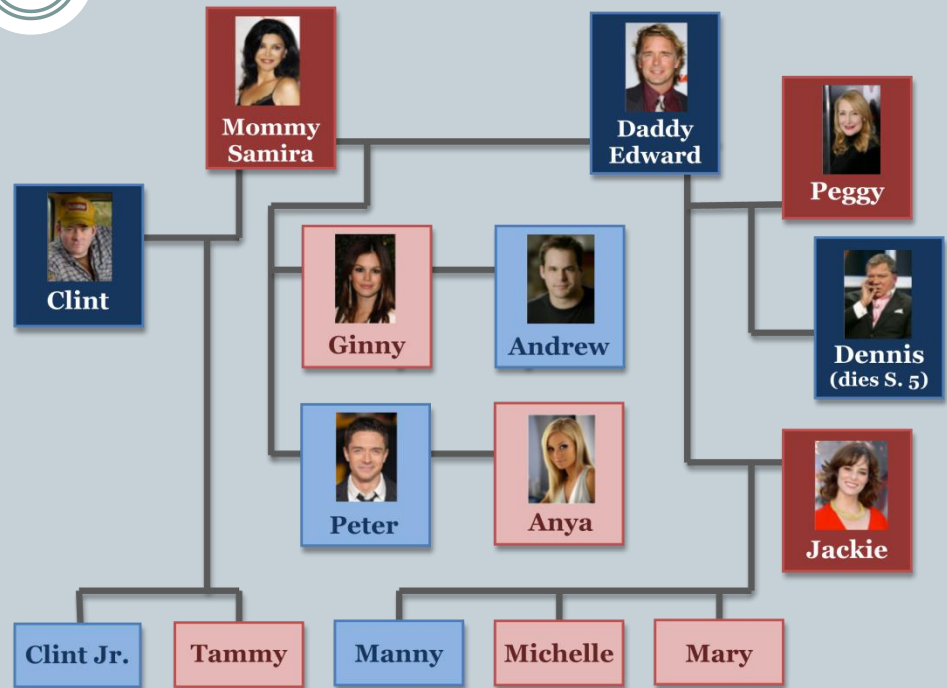
Conflict? What conflict?
